29. Yes No 29. A-1, while dribbling, sees she is about to be overtaken by B-1. A-1 cuts in front of B-1 so quickly that B-1 can't avoid contact. The official rules a player-control foul. Is the official correct?
30. Yes No 30. There are 1.7 seconds remaining in the game. Team A is leading by one and has the ball for a throw-in on the end line in the backcourt. A-1 throws a baseball pass toward his basket in the frontcourt. The ball hits the floor inbounds and is headed out of bounds untouched. A-5 steps on the end line, jumps and taps the ball back inbounds. The official rules a throw-in violation and awards the ball to Team B at the spot of A-1's throw-in. Is the official correct?
